

Mr. Konstantin Dobrynin

Konstantin has been an official representative of Pen & Paper in London since March 2019.

He represented the Arkhangelsk Region for four years as a member of the Federation Council of the Russian Federal Assembly (senator) and Deputy Chair of the Federation Council Committee for Constitutional Legislation and State Construction, and was the plenipotentiary representative of the Federation Council at the Russian Justice Ministry. Through his active work in the upper chamber of the Russian Parliament he has become an acknowledged legislative expert among the legal community and has been responsible for over 70 legislative initiatives, most of which have since become federal laws.

Since October 2015 Konstantin has served as State Secretary and Deputy President of the Russian Federal Bar Association. He is responsible for cooperating with state authorities such as the Parliament, the Government, the Prosecutor General's Office and others. His functions also include coordinating issues on improving the legislation of the Bar Institution in Russia, organising work on draft bills and promoting the Bar as a special institution for protecting the constitutional rights of citizens, including the professional image of lawyers.
