Ms. Melissa K. Pang is the Immediate Past President of the Law Society of Hong Kong. Ms. Pang was elected the first female President of the Law Society in 2018, and re-elected in 2019 and 2020. Ms. Pang currently serves as Chairperson of Pro Bono and Community Work Recognition Committee; Member of Standing Committee on Policy and Resources and Mediation Committee. She was the Founding Chairperson of International Legal Affairs Committee and Pro Bono Committee.



Ms. Pang is qualified to practise as a solicitor in Australia, England & Wales and Hong Kong. She is a Notary Public, Civil Celebrant, accredited mediator, Council Member of the Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Limited, associate member of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators, and China Appointed Attesting Officer.

Also, Ms. Pang is the President-Elect of LAWASIA and Council Member of Commonwealth Lawyers Association.

Ms Pang is the Chairman of the Family Council and the Hong Kong Press Council, the Vice-chairman of Agency for Volunteer Service. She is also member of Operations Review Committee of the ICAC (Independent Commission Against Corruption), Hong Kong Housing Authority and the Women's Commission. With her devotion to public service, Ms Pang was awarded by the Hong Kong SAR Government the Medal of Honour in 2006, Justice of the Peace in 2010 and the Bronze Bauhinia Star in 2020.
