Dr. James Ding is the Law Officer (International Law), Department of Justice of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. He heads the International Law Division and reports to the Secretary for Justice on issues of international law and international legal cooperation. He has been awarded with the Chief Executive's Commendation for Government/Public Services in 2021.

He has published on different subjects of international law and international cooperation, and has given various presentations at international and regional conferences, including HCCH, UNCITRAL and UNIDROIT events. He is also currently the Chair of APEC Economic Committee.

He obtained LL.B.(Hons) and Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (Distinction) from the University of Hong Kong, LL.M. from Kyushu University, Japan (under Monbusho scholarship) and Ph.D. from the University of Queensland, Australia. He also received various training in laws and management at Fudan University, Tsinghua University, Chinese Academy of Governance, International Law Institute and the University of Oxford. He became a barrister in Hong Kong in 1997 and joined the Department of Justice in 1999. He also taught law on a part-time basis at the University of Hong Kong and the Open University of Hong Kong from 1998 to 1999.
