Chief Superintendent of Police; Wanchai Police District Commander; and Commanding Officer of Police Negotiation Cadre, Hong Kong Police Force of The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China

Stephen Liauw, currently serving as Chief Superintendent, initiated his journey with the Hong Kong Police Force as an Inspector in 2002. His consistent dedication led to promotions to Chief Inspector in 2011, Superintendent in 2016, Senior Superintendent in 2020, and Chief Superintendent in 2023. He now commands the Wanchai Police District.

In 2006, Stephen expanded his skill set by joining the Police Negotiation Cadre (PNC). He has been instrumental in over a hundred crisis negotiation cases, involving suicide intervention, handling barricaded subjects, and resolving hostage situations. As the current Commanding Officer of PNC, Stephen leads approximately 100 cadre members, vigilantly responding to crisis incidents in Hong Kong around the clock. His commitment to maintaining peace is evident in his tireless service.
