Teresa Cheng is a Senior Counsel, Chartered Engineer, Chartered Arbitrator, with a distinguished record of public service in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR).

From January 2018 to June 2022, Ms Cheng was the Secretary for Justice of the Hong Kong SAR. Ms Cheng is a member of panel of arbitrators of ICSID, first designated by the Chairman of the Administrative Council in 2011 and by China in 2017. She specialises in a wide range of legal areas, including construction, shareholders disputes, international commercial contracts and investment disputes, and is an experienced practitioner in arbitration and mediation. She is frequently engaged as counsel and arbitrator in complex international commercial/investment disputes.

She is one of the founder members and co-chairman of the Asian Academy of International Law (AAIL), Past Vice President of the International Council of Commercial Arbitration (ICCA), Past Vice President of the ICC International Court of Arbitration, Past President of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrator.

She is also an active law academician, where she is a Fellow of King's College London, and is Course Director of the International Arbitration and Dispute Settlement Course which she set up in 2012, at the Law School of Tsinghua University in Beijing, China.
