UK NATIONAL RISK ASSESSMENT OF MONEY LAUNDERING AND TERRORIST FINANCING 2025

- Legal Service Providers continue to be assessed at High risk of ML and Low risk of TF.
- Trust or Company Service Providers (TCSPs) continue to be assessed at High risk of ML. However, TCSPs have been assessed at an increased (from Low to) Medium risk of TF.

Where TCSPs increased from Low to Medium, the NRA 2025 reports that this increased risk has been caused by an increased understanding of how the TCSP sector is exposed to organisational TF risks (internationally rather than NIRT) and there is no information to show a change in scale of TF through the TCSP sector since 2020.
