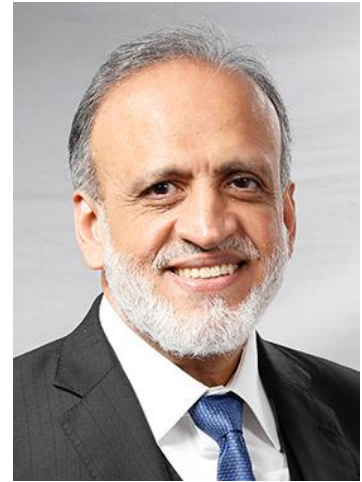


Mr. Amirali Nasir
