

Prof. Dr. Matthias Kilian

Professor of Law, The University of Cologne

Prof. Dr. Matthias Kilian is the Hans-Soldan-Professor for the Law of the Legal Profession at the University of Cologne, the only professorship in Germany dedicated exclusively to the regulation of the legal profession and legal ethics. He is director of the Institute on the Law of of the Legal Profession, the oldest and most renowned research institute of its kind in Germany, and also the Director of the Soldan Institute for Empirical Studies on the Legal Profession based in Cologne. Kilian has been one of Germany's leading legal scholars in the field of the regulation of the legal profession and legal ethics He has published widely in this field and is the author and/or editor of a number of standard handbooks and commentaries on lawyers and legal ethics and of the Statistical Yearbook of the German legal profession. As a renowned expert in his field, he has advised the German Federal Parliament and the German Federal Constitutional Court on various occasions and provided expert advice on the regulation of legal services, professional responsibility, legal education, legal tech regulation and costs laws. As an internationally recognized expert on legal ethics, Kilian has been a board member of the International Association of Legal Ethics (IAOLE) since 2014, and was the first German legal scholar to be elected as its president in 2022.
