

**Mr. Jimmy Chan**

Jimmy Chan is a Council Member of the Law Society of Hong Kong and serves as Chairman of its Standing Committee on Compliance.

Jimmy brings over two decades of experience in financial regulation, including 14 years at the Hong Kong Securities and Futures Commission (SFC). Before he left the SFC, he held the position of Director and Head of International and Policy within the Enforcement Division. He was twice honored with the SFC’s Outstanding Individual Award for his role in resolving the Lehman Brothers Minibond crisis and his contributions to securities and futures appellate work.

In his role as Chairman of the Law Society’s Standing Committee on Compliance, Jimmy oversees conduct investigations and disciplinary actions within the legal profession.

Jimmy earned his law degree from the University of Hong Kong and pursued further legal studies at University College London (as a British Chevening Scholar), Harvard Law School (as a Harvard University–HKJC Graduate Fellow), and Peking University. He is admitted as a solicitor in Hong Kong SAR, a lawyer in the Greater Bay Area (PRC), a non-practising solicitor in England and Wales, and an attorney-at-law in the State of New York.
