Visiting the U.S.

How do I apply?

- 1. Pay the non-refundable application fee of HK\$520 per application. This fee must be paid in advance at any branch of Dah Sing Bank.
- Complete application form DS-156 (provided by Dah Sing Bank upon payment of visa application fee) Application form may also be downloaded from the Consulate General's Website.
 - (New Requirement: All male nonimmigrant visa applicants between the ages of 16 and 45 must fill out and submit a DS-157 in addition to the usual DS-156.)
- 3. Submit a recent photo, 1.4 inches square (37x37 mm), showing full face, against a light background.
- 4. Submit the completed application form, the bank receipt and a passport valid for at least six months beyond the intended stay in the U.S.
- Submit the above items and supporting documents any workday morning from 8:30 to 11:30 AM.

How long will it take?

Approved visas will be issued by 4:00 PM the same working day whenever possible. The time may vary a day or more during our busier times. Please apply early.

What are the basic requirements for a visitor visa?

The prime criterion for issuance of most non-immigrant visas is whether the applicant can convince the consular officer that the applicant truly intends to return to Hong Kong/Macau after a temporary stay in the U.S. Each applicant must keep in mind that the interview will focus on his or her personal situation (or circumstances) and not on the documents presented.

What documents do I need to provide?

It is impossible to specify the exact documents you should bring since each applicant's circumstances vary greatly. Documents that show the purpose of the trip, intent to depart the United States and arrangements to cover the costs of the trip may help to convince the consular officer. Supporting documents most often presented are: personal financial documents including inland revenue receipt, deeds to property owned or property tax-rate demands, recent current account statements and bank books. If you are applying for a tourist visa, please bring a leave letter from your employer or school principal. If you are applying for a business visa: a letter of sponsorship from firm; correspondence concerning proposed trip; business profits tax statement; recent current account statements of the firm; etc.
