The Personal Data (Privacy) (Amendment) Ordinance 2021 has come into effect to combat doxxing

The Personal Data (Privacy) (Amendment) Ordinance 2021 (Amendment Ordinance) was published in the gazette and came into effect on 8 October 2021 to combat doxxing acts that are intrusive to personal data privacy.

The objectives of the Amendment Ordinance include the criminalisation of doxxing act, empowering the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data (Privacy Commissioner) to carry out criminal investigations and institute prosecutions for doxxing and related offences, and conferring on the Privacy Commissioner statutory powers to demand the cessation of disclosure of doxxing messages.

To this end, I enclose herewith our promotional poster and leaflet of the Amendment Ordinance for your information and deployment. Please feel free to circulate them to your colleagues and relevant stakeholders.
