- (a) With the integration of LawTech and AI in legal services delivery being a seeming inevitable trend, what are the 3 top steps that you and/or your firm are taking to **prepare for the impact** (e.g., updated policies and governance, trialing and procuring new services/products, hardware and systems upgrades, capability building, recruitment and restructuring, updating mindsets, data collection and cleansing, etc.)?
- (b) What are or will be the **main challenges** in this gearing up process, and **what industry-wide initiatives will help** alleviate these challenges?
