Information for Contestants

Event: Recreation and Sports Club for Hong Kong Professional Bodies (“RSCP”) Golf Tournament 2026 (19th Joint Professional Golf Tournament (“JPGT”))

Venue: The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club (“CWBGCC”), Clearwater Bay (139 Tai Au Mun Road, Clearwater Bay, N.T.)

Date: **22 April 2026 (Wednesday)**

Time: Below is the programme rundown:

10:30	Registration	Participants shall: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• pass the golf bags to staff of CWBGCC next to the golf club entrance before registration; and• report to the registration counter next to the pro shop at CWBGCC, and show their driving license and sign declaration form.

Entrance fee:

- **HK\$1,400** per head for CWBGCC member
- **HK\$2,500** per head for non-CWBGCC member

Format: Net Strokes Team Competition off **New New Peoria handicap (“NNP”)**

Handicap: **28 (Maximum)**

Tees: **Red tees** for ladies, and **white tees** for men.

No. of players: Each professional body can register up to **15 competing participants**. No shows or withdrawals after official confirmation will still be subject to full payment of the registration fee.

Team scores: NNP system will be used to determine the handicap of each contestant. The net score of the **best 12 contestants of each team** shall be counted. The professional body which has the lowest aggregate score is the winner.

Tie of score: In the event of a tie in score, the **total sum of the handicap of the 12 relevant contestants** will be used to determine the winning team. The team with a lower handicap score shall win. If a tie still remains after taken into account the handicap score, both teams will be awarded the same ranking.



Prizes: The prizes of the tournament are set out below:

- (1) The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the Champion team which can keep it for one year until the next tournament is held.
- (2) A medal for the **champion, 2nd and 3rd prizes** of the participating team.
- (3) A trophy for the player from each team who has the Best Gross Score.
- (4) A trophy for the player from each team who has the Best Net Score unless that person also has the Best Gross Score.
- (5) A trophy for each winner who wins the Nearest to Pin (**all par-3 holes, i.e. Holes 1, 4, 6, 11, 14 and 16**).
- (6) A trophy for each winner who has the Longest Drive (Holes 2 and 13). There will be **separate longest drives** for ladies and men when there are two (2) or more lady golfers.
- (7) Each player is entitled to win **no more than one (1) Nearest to Pin Prize and one (1) Longest Drive Prize**.
- (8) Only players who **stay for the dinner buffet** are eligible to participate in the lucky draw.

Special Tournament Rules:

- (1) Drop Zones on **Holes 2, 3, 9 and 17** are in play.
- (2) When a player's ball is lost or out of bounds ("OB") upon teeing-off, he/ she will incur **one stroke penalty** and must proceed to play his/ her third shot at the designated Drop Zone.
- (3) For all other loss of balls or OB, the player will incur one stroke penalty and must drop his/ her ball within two club' length from the point of entry not nearer to the pin. **All loss ball will be treated as red stakes.**
- (4) At any hole, a player should pick up his/ her ball if he/ she is at double par of the hole (i.e. 6 for Par 3, 8 for Par 4, and 10 for Par 5) and use that as his/ her score for that hole.
- (5) At any hole, putts shall be given if the ball is within the **metal part** of the flight captain's putter and the player shall **add one stroke** as his/ her score for that hole.
- (6) All types of Yardage rangefinders are allowed in this tournament.

Disputes:

- Any dispute shall be raised through the captains of each team to the Organising Committee right after the tournament and before the prize presentation ceremony.
- Complaints after the event will not be entertained.
- The Organising Committee is comprised of a representative from each professional body and its decision shall be final. Royal and Ancient Rules and local rules prevail.



Miscellaneous:

- (1) The player with the lowest handicap in each flight shall be designated the **captain** of the flight.
- (2) The flight captain shall ensure that the speed of play is brisk and that the scores are marked properly on the scorecards. Each player shall hand-in an individual SIGNED scorecard. **The flight captain of each team is responsible to collect four (4) scorecards and pass the scorecards to HKDA support staff at reception next to the pro shop as soon as the game is finished.**
- (3) **Each player is required to exchange his scorecard with his/ her teammate for marking. Please write down GROSS score for each hole.**
- (4) Disagreements within a team will be decided by the **captain** of that flight.
- (5) Golf carts are included in the tournament fees.
- (6) A **valid driving licence** is required for players who wish to drive a golf cart. Those without a driving licence are required to ride with a licenced driver.
- (7) **Do not** take the whole golf bag to Driving Range as it will be placed onto golf cart.
- (8) **Dress code:** Please visit the [CWBGCC website](#) for details.
- (9) **Golf insurance: No golf insurance is provided by the Organiser.** Participants are strongly encouraged to take out golf insurance for participation in the 19th JPGT.
- (10) Players are advised to **arrive ahead of time** to secure parking within CWBGCC on the event day.
