**Background**

- The LexGoTech Roundtable Series was launched by the Department of Justice (“**DoJ**”) convening stakeholders across the legal ecosystem to share their visions, first-hand experience and practical tips on the use and potential of LawTech in legal practices in Hong Kong.
- With the support of the Consultation Group on LawTech Development and various legal professional associations, four rounds of the Roundtables have been convened since June 2025.
- The DoJ released the “LexGoTech Roundtables Report” during the inaugural Hong Kong LawTech Fest in December 2025 sharing the key insights gathered from the Roundtables on the impact of LawTech ([https://www.doj.gov.hk/en/publications/pdf/LexGoTech\\_Roundtables\\_Report\\_en.pdf](https://www.doj.gov.hk/en/publications/pdf/LexGoTech_Roundtables_Report_en.pdf)).

**Objectives**

- As a further step of the DoJ’s efforts in promoting the development and use of LawTech in Hong Kong, the DoJ presents the fifth round of the Series, bringing together key stakeholders to explore the current

landscape of LawTech services in Hong Kong, with the aim of deepening participants' understanding of how these innovations are being applied in the legal sector and how the competitiveness of Hong Kong legal services could be further enhanced with the use of technology.

### **Who should join?**

- Members of the two legal professional bodies are invited to join.

### **What to expect?**

- Beyond raising awareness, this Roundtable features “Lightning LawTech Demonstrations” by LawTech service providers through which participants could explore the latest LawTech tools.
- The demonstrations seek to help participants identify the potential of the LawTech tools in their practice, while gauging the legal professionals' readiness and appetite to adopt LawTech services.

### **Next steps**

- We seek to identify the technology categories and tools that best align with the daily practices relies on gathering the legal professionals' perspectives and further understand their specific needs, operational concerns, and the key factors that would drive greater LawTech adoption.
- Discussion from this Roundtable and feedback from participants would provide insights in assisting the DoJ in formulating policies and measures to further promote the adoption of LawTech by the legal industry, including the possibility of a short-term funding programme for eligible members of the legal profession.
