**Secondment Programme to
the Permanent Bureau of the Hague Conference on Private
International Law (HCCH) in The Hague;
the International Institute for the Unification of Private Law
(UNIDROIT) in Rome; and the International Organization for
Mediation (IOMed) in Hong Kong
(Repeat Circular)**

1. It is the policy initiative of the Department of Justice (DoJ) to nurture local legal talents through continuous provision of training opportunities, especially in the practice of foreign-related legal affairs, including secondment arrangements with relevant international organisations. By participating in the work of such organisations, local legal talents could gain knowledge of the operation of international organisations, broaden their horizons through working with international law experts, and inject a Hong Kong perspective in shaping the development of international law.
2. [Hague Conference on Private International Law \(HCCH\)](#)

Since December 2020, a standing arrangement has been put in place with the HCCH for seconding Hong Kong legal professionals in both the public and private sectors to the Permanent Bureau of the HCCH at The Hague, the Netherlands. This arrangement was made pursuant to an agreement concluded between the Central People's Government and the HCCH, and a memorandum of understanding signed between the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSARG) and the HCCH on 22 December 2020.

3. [International Institute for the Unification of Private Law \(UNIDROIT\)](#)

In line with the above policy initiative, a standing arrangement has been put in place with UNIDROIT for seconding Hong Kong legal professionals in both the public and private sectors to the Secretariat of UNIDROIT in Rome, Italy. This arrangement has been made pursuant to an agreement concluded between the Central People's Government and UNIDROIT, and a memorandum of understanding signed between the HKSARG and UNIDROIT on 12 May 2021.



4. [International Organization for Mediation \(IOMed\)](#)

The IOMed is the world's first intergovernmental legal organisation dedicated to resolving international disputes through mediation. With its Headquarters established in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, IOMed commenced operations on 20 October 2025. A standing arrangement has been put in place with the IOMed for seconding Hong Kong legal professionals to the IOMed Secretariat. This arrangement has been made pursuant to an exchange of notes between the Central People's Government and the IOMed, and a memorandum of understanding signed between the HKSARG and the IOMed on 27 January 2026.

5. DoJ invites members to join the secondment programme. Application for the 2026 recruitment exercise for the secondment programmes **will close on 24 February 2026**.

Co-option of Organising Committee Members (Repeat Circular)

1. The Cross Strait Four Regions Young Lawyers Forum (“the Forum”) is an annual flagship event organised by the Law Society since 2011 to provide a platform for young lawyers from the Greater China region to exchange and network.
2. On 25 November 2025, the Forum was successfully held at the Charles K. Kao Auditorium (“Golden Egg”) of Hong Kong Science Park under the theme “DARE – Data & Digitalisation, Artificial Intelligence, Robotics, and E-Commerce”, which brought together over 300 participants from 30 lawyers’ associations and government departments, joining both onsite and online.



3. A highlight of the Forum last year was the presentation of the Young Lawyers’ Manifesto, jointly led by representatives of more than twenty lawyers’ associations across the Greater China region. Reinterpreting “DARE” as Determination, Accountability, Resilience, and Ethics, the Manifesto reaffirms the commitment of young lawyers to embrace technological innovation as a force that elevates the legal profession.

1. Building on the success of the internship programmes jointly organised with the Korean Bar Association and the Korean Ministry of Justice since 2014, the Law Society will continue the two-week Korean Internship Programme in 2026.

Inbound Programme (Korean interns to Hong Kong)

2. This year's inbound programme will take place from 3 to 14 August 2026. The Law Society calls on support from our members' law firms and legal unit of corporations to host the selected English-speaking Korean interns. The interns will ensure their own compliance with the Hong Kong training visa requirements, with the Law Society as the sponsoring company. They will also bear all travel and accommodation expenses related to their participation in the programme. No remuneration is payable for the internship.
3. While the Law Society will tentatively organise orientation and networking activities on the first day (3 August 2026) and last day (14 August 2026), participating law firms and corporations are expected to provide their own training programmes for the interns during their stay, including but not limited to practical work assignments with the law firm/corporation, visit(s), meeting(s), professional exchanges, networking activities, and/or other meaningful exposure to Hong Kong's legal profession.

Outbound Programme (Hong Kong interns to Korea)

**26-114 (SD) LAUNCH OF THE ANTI-MONEY
LAUNDERING/COUNTER TERRORIST FINANCING
COMPLIANCE SELF-ASSESSMENT FORM
(Repeat Circular)**

1. As the designated regulatory body under the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorist Financing Ordinance (Cap. 615), the Law Society is committed to supporting its members in managing money laundering and terrorist-financing risks effectively. Alongside this commitment, the Law Society has a statutory duty to oversee members' compliance with the statutory Client Due Diligence ("CDD") and record-keeping requirements. To fulfil these responsibilities, the Law Society is enhancing its supervisory framework through a proportionate, risk-based approach.
2. This work is also being undertaken to address the recommendations set out by the Financial Action Task Force ("FATF") in the [Mutual Evaluation Report of Hong Kong \(2019\)](#), which called on the Law Society to establish a robust, risk-based AML supervision of legal professionals.

Mandatory Anti-Money Laundering/Counter-Terrorist Financing Compliance Self-Assessment Form ("AML/CTF Form")

3. As part of ongoing efforts to meet FATF recommendations and enhance sector-wide compliance, the Law Society is rolling out the AML/CTF Form. Completion and online submission of this form is mandatory for all law firms in Hong Kong. This requirement is based on a resolution by the Council of the Law Society. As the designated regulatory AML supervisory body, the Law Society has a statutory duty to oversee members' compliance with the AML/CTF obligations.
4. **Completion of the AML/CTF Form is an important part of meeting the Law Society's professional responsibilities, and non-compliance may be treated as professional misconduct.**



5. The AML/CTF Form is designed to guide firms in reviewing their own compliance with the AML/CTF requirements and to help identify areas where additional guidance or training may be useful. It will also assist the Law Society in understanding where support is most needed and in developing practical guidance and other resources for members.
6. The goal is to make compliance easier and more collaborative, to establish a shared understanding of AML/CTF requirements across the sector, support firms in strengthening their compliance frameworks, and provide an opportunity to raise questions.

How to Complete the AML/CTF Form?

- (a) **Online access to the Form:** The link for online submission of the AML/CTF Form is available on the Law Society's AML website under the "[AML/CTF Compliance Self-Assessment Form](#)" tab. Please click [here](#) to access the link to the AML/CTF Form. On the AML website, members will also find a comprehensive [Frequently Asked Questions](#) document to assist with completing the form, as well as a sample AML/CTF Form for reference purposes only. **Please note that all responses to the AML/CTF Form must be submitted online using the link provided on the AML website; submissions by email or post will not be accepted.**
- (b) **Submission Deadline:** **2 March 2026**
- (c) **Submission Method:** [Online only](#) (no email or postal submissions)
- (d) **Relevant Period of Self-Assessment:** 1 January 2025 – 31 December 2025
- (e) **Complete All Required Fields:** Enter your information accurately.
- (f) **Submission of the AML/CTF Form:** Click the "Submit" button at the end of the form. The Law Society will receive your submission automatically, and you will receive a confirmation email.
- (g) **Record Keeping:** Refer to the front page of the AML/CTF Form for instructions on saving your submission and making amendments if needed.

Training and Engagement Opportunities:

7. To support firms in meeting their AML/CTF obligations, the Law Society will deliver targeted training sessions starting in 2026, both on-site and through webinars or workshops. These sessions will focus on the following areas:
 - Scope of compliance and CDD requirements
 - Red flags and risk indicators
 - Suspicious transaction reporting
 - Law Society's compliance tools.
