**26-150 (PA) INVITATION TO APPLY FOR CONSIDERATION
FOR APPOINTMENT AS
DEPUTY JUDGES OF THE COURT OF FIRST INSTANCE
(NON-REFOULMENT CLAIMS)**

1. The Judiciary launched a special scheme (the “Scheme”) in February 2025 to appoint eligible practitioners as Deputy Judges of the Court of First Instance (Non-Refoulment Claims) exclusively for handling non-refoulment claims.
2. The Law Society has been invited by the Judiciary to nominate eligible members to be considered by the Chief Judge of the High Court for appointment as Deputy Judges of the Court of First Instance (Non-Refoulment Claims). Suitable candidates, as determined by the Chief Judge of the High Court, will be recommended to the Chief Justice for consideration of appointment.
3. Members who would like to be considered by Council for nomination and have a minimum of 10 years of post-qualification experience can send their CVs to Deputy Secretary General and Director of Practitioners Affairs at the Secretariat of the Law Society via email at: <mailto:dpa@hklawsoc.org.hk> marked "**Nomination for Appointment of Deputy Judges of the Court of First Instance (Non-Refoulment Claims)**" on or before **2 April 2026**. Experience in non-refoulment cases is not required. Members are reminded that the Judiciary may take into account a range of factors when assessing suitability, and the Law Society is not in a position to advise on or interpret the Judiciary’s assessment criteria. Members should note that nomination by the Law Society does not guarantee selection or appointment, as all such decisions rest solely with the Judiciary.

Note: The personal data provided in the CV submitted will be used for the purposes of considering nomination and any subsequent steps relating to the appointment. By submitting your CV, you understand and agree that the Law Society may provide your personal data provided in the CV to relevant committees, Council and the Judiciary for the aforesaid purposes.

**26-154 (PA) MANDATORY PROVIDENT FUND
REVISED GUIDELINES
(GUIDELINES III.2)**

1. The Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority (“Authority”) has issued the revised Guidelines on Equities and Other Securities (Guidelines III.2), which came into effect on 10 March 2026.
2. According to the Authority, the purpose of the revisions is to reflect the inclusion of active exchange traded funds that are authorised by, and not classified as derivative funds by, the Securities and Futures Commission and listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange as permissible investment for MPF funds, subject to an aggregate limit of 10% of net asset value of an MPF fund. Some housekeeping changes have also been made to Guidelines III.2.

I. Applications for the 2026 Overseas Lawyers Qualification Examination

1. The Information Package for the Overseas Lawyers Qualification Examination (“the Examination”) in 2026 (“[2026 Information Package](#)”) and the Application Form (“Application Form”) are available on the website of the Law Society at www.hklawsoc.org.hk.
2. Kindly note that for the 2026 Examination, applicants may elect to submit the **online Application Form** **or** **paper-based Application Form**. In either case, applicants are required to submit all supporting documents and information and effect payment of an application fee of HK\$6,600 by **Friday, 20 March 2026**.
3. The 2026 Information Package has been updated with the following major amendments:

(i) Part I – Overseas Lawyers Qualification Examination

Section C – Overseas Lawyers Qualification Examination Information

(Both online Application Form and paper-based Application Form are available at the [Law Society’s website](#))



If an applicant wishes to submit his application via online Application Form, he will pay the application fee of HK\$6,600 via online payment options including but not limited to credit/debit cards (VISA, Mastercard, Union Pay), Faster Payment System (FPS), Alipay, WeChat Pay. Details of online payment options and procedures will be provided during the online submission process.

Alternatively, if an applicant wishes to submit the paper-based Application Form, he will have to pay the requisite fee by cheque, bank draft or cashier order payable to “The Law Society of Hong Kong” as online payment options are not available for submission of paper-based Application Form.

As the Application Form contains a statutory declaration pursuant to the provisions of the Oaths and Declarations Ordinance (Cap.11, Laws of Hong Kong) (i.e. Item 30 in the Application Form), an applicant is strongly reminded to return the original Application Form with the duly executed statutory declaration together with all supporting documents to the Department of Standards and Development **on or before 20 March 2026** for processing the application no matter an applicant is submitting the online Application Form or paper-based Application Form.

Mode of examination for 2026 Examination

The written Heads of the 2026 Examination (i.e. Heads I, II, III, IV and VI) (collectively, “Written Heads” and each, a “Written Head”) will be conducted **in a computer-based format**. An applicant is required to bring his own laptop computer to the Examination venue to take the Examination. An applicant has to pre-install the prescribed computer software for the computer-based Examination (“Lockdown Browser”) in his laptop computer prior to the Examination. Details of the installation and operation of the Lockdown Browser (including the taking of a practice examination) will be provided to candidates in due course.

A review of the Law Society’s decision under section 9 of the Overseas Lawyers (Qualification for Admission) Rules (“OLQE Rules”)

The application fee of HK\$3,000 can be made by cheque, bank draft or cashier order payable to “The Law Society of Hong Kong” or by online payment options, details of which will be provided to applicants in due course.

Procedure for registration to sit the 2026 Examination

Candidates can pay the registration fee in accordance with the Overseas Lawyers (Qualification for Admission) (Fees) Rules by cheque, bank draft or cashier order payable to “The Law Society of Hong Kong” or by online payment options, details of which will be provided to candidates in due course.



Withdrawal from sitting the Examination

If an applicant is unable to take the Examination after he has been issued a Section 3(2) Certificate issued under the OLQE Rules (“Section 3(2) Certificate”) but before he has registered his intention to sit the Examination, he may apply by letter, before the expiry of the Section 3(2) Certificate, for an extension of its validity period to enable him to take the next sitting. The application fee of HK\$1,500 can be paid by cheque, bank draft or cashier order payable to “The Law Society of Hong Kong” or by online payment options, details of which will be provided to applicants in due course.

Computers/calculators, mobile phones etc.

As the Written Heads of the Examination (i.e. Heads I, II, III, IV, VI) will be conducted **in a computer-based format**, an applicant is required to bring his own laptop computer to the Examination venue to take the Examination. He has to pre-install the Lockdown Browser in his laptop computer prior to the Examination. Details of the installation and operation of the Lockdown Browser will be provided to candidates in due course. He may also bring and use a silent and non-programmable calculator in the Examination. He is strongly advised not to bring any electronic/communication devices other than the laptop computer required for him to take the Examination (e.g. tablet, i-watches, smart watches, PDA, mobile phones, pagers, ear phones, ear pieces) into the Examination. If an applicant has brought along any of such devices, he must turn it off (including the alarm function) and put it under his seat in a position clearly visible to the invigilators. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Candidates with incapacities or disabilities

Any candidate who is incapable to take computer-based Examination or suffers from a disability necessitating special requirements to sit the computer-based Examination should make an application in writing addressed to the Director of Standards and Development **not less than six weeks** prior to the commencement date of the Examination (on or before 11 September 2026):

- advising the nature of the incapacity or disability and its effect in relation to ability to sit the computer-based Examination;
- including a medical report/certificate in support; and
- specifying the special requirements requested.



The application will be considered by the Overseas Lawyers Qualification Examination Committee.

A candidate is required to provide reason(s) for any application made after the deadline of 11 September 2026. The Law Society reserves the right not to consider any late applications.

Application for review of applicant's script

The application fee of HK\$3,000 per Head for a review of the answer(s)/script(s) by the Chief Examiners can be paid by cheque, bank draft or cashier order payable to "The Law Society of Hong Kong" or by online payment options, details of which will be provided to applicants in due course.

Section F-Guidelines for Exemption from sitting all or parts of the Examination

Meaning of "experience in the practice of law"

If an applicant's pre-admission experience such as in-house experience has been recognised by the regulatory authority as equivalent to the completion of statutory training period and as satisfying the admission criteria in the applicant's jurisdiction of admission, the applicant must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Law Society that such pre-admission experience is comparable to the training required for admission and/or is relevant experience in the practice of law and that documentary evidence of attaining relevant experience in addition to the recognition of such pre-admission experience by the regulatory authority of the applicant's jurisdiction of admission must be provided.

Section G-Application Form

In view of the introduction of online Application Form and online payment options, the Personal Information Collection Statement in the Application Form has been revised. Consequential amendments to Items 29 and 30 of the Application Form have also been revised.

**For The Law Course For The School Of Foreign Affairs and Law Of East
China University of Political Science and Law
(華東政法大學涉外法治學院)**

1. From 2019 to 2025, a law course titled “Legal Services and Risk Management for Cross-border Transactions”, focusing on legal practice under the common law system, cross-border legal services, and specialised areas of Hong Kong legal practice, was conducted annually for law students at Peking University Law School (“PKU”) (北京大學).
2. The successful experience gained from the collaboration with PKU laid down a solid foundation for extending similar initiatives to other top-tier Mainland universities. Between November 2024 and November 2025, another four lecture series were conducted for the School of Foreign Affairs and Law of East China University of Political Science and Law (“ECUPL”), China University of Political Science and Law (中國政法大學), and Renmin University of China Law School (中國人民大學). These courses were well received by students, guest audiences, and our members who participated as volunteer lecturers.
3. A re-run of the law course titled “International Commercial Dispute Resolution and Arbitration” for ECUPL is scheduled for 18 April to 13 June 2026. It is a credit-bearing and English-taught course and will be conducted in person on Saturdays and a Sunday at ECUPL’s Shanghai campus.
4. We are now recruiting enthusiastic volunteer lecturers to deliver lectures for ECUPL. The course outline and the reply slip are in [Annexure 1](#) and [Annexure 2](#) respectively.

Law Week Overview

1. Law Week, one of the renowned annual flagship community programmes of the Law Society, exemplifies the Law Society's commitment to providing legal knowledge, promoting legal services, and elevating the image of the legal profession. Over the past three decades, Law Week has offered a wide range of activities, including the signature "Free Legal Advice Programme", free community legal talks, and partnerships with NGOs to provide volunteer services to those in need.

Law Week 2025 Highlights

2. Themed "法治連線，共建未來, Law in Action: Building the Future Together", Law Week 2025 hosted a variety of impactful events, including the Opening Ceremony in September 2025, "Drawing and Legal Quiz Competition", which attracted over 100 creative entries and drew nearly 2,000 participants, the "Law Week 2025" Closing Ceremony in December 2025 and the "Legal Frisbee Challenge Day" in February 2026.
3. Volunteer solicitors provided free legal consultations in Tin Shui Wai, Ma On Shan, and Sham Shui Po throughout the event, delivering over 3,600 minutes of advice on topics including employees' compensation, personal injury, family law, criminal law, landlord-tenant issues, conveyancing, wills and probate, building management, and commercial disputes—boosting public legal awareness.
4. A total of four Community Legal Talks were held on various topics, including "Living Between Hong Kong and the Mainland: Legal Issues You Need to Know," "Three Instruments of Peace", Cyber Crime, Cyberbullying and Cyber. These talks were well received by the audiences.
