26-396 (PA) LEGAL REPRESENTATION FOR LEGAL VISITS

1. The Law Society understands from the Correctional Services Department (“CSD”) that in some recent cases, barristers have presented letters of authorisation issued by law firms to request legal visits without being accompanied by a solicitor or an authorised solicitors’ clerk.
2. Members are reminded of [Circular 25-634 \(PA\)](#) on the [agreed arrangements](#) reached with law enforcement agencies, including the CSD, on legal visits. In particular, members are reminded to adhere to the agreed arrangement that either a solicitor, a trainee solicitor or an authorised solicitors’ clerk must attend legal visits with barristers. Any instance where members of The Law Society permit a barrister to request or conduct legal visits at police stations or the CSD facilities, including the cells of the Magistrates’ Courts, the District Court and the High Court or other law enforcement agencies without the presence of a solicitor, a trainee solicitor, or an authorised solicitors’ clerk would constitute professional misconduct, and The Law Society would take appropriate action.
3. In addition, members are reminded to observe The Hong Kong Solicitors' Guide to Professional Conduct (Volume 1) (“the Guide”) for the purpose of legal visits, including the following:
 - a) A solicitor cannot abrogate his responsibility to his client by instructing a barrister (*see Principle 6.01 Commentary 6*). [[Principle 12.03](#) of the Guide]
 - b) If assistance is required, a solicitor has a duty to select a competent person to assist and thereafter continues to be bound, professionally and legally, to exercise his independent judgment in the matter. If a barrister is instructed, take particular note of Principle 12.03. A solicitor should not allow his own skill and judgment to be entirely dominated by counsel. [Davy-Chiesman v Davy-Chiesman [1984] 1 ALL ER 321 (CA)]. [*Commentary 6 of [Principle 6.01](#) of the Guide*]

26-403 (PA) IP TRAINING PROGRAMME SERIES – IP303 CASE SHARING ON PATENT BOX REGIME

1. The Intellectual Property Department (“IPD”) is inviting members of the Law Society to attend an Intellectual Property (“IP”) training course, titled “IP303 Case Sharing on Patent Box Regime” on 17 July 2026 (“the IP Training Course”). The IP Training Course is designated for legal advisors and IP practitioners, as well as entrepreneurs, IP owners, executives and managers of local startups, small and medium enterprises and large enterprises.
2. The Government has implemented the “patent box” tax incentive in July 2024 to encourage the industrial and research and development (“R&D”) sectors, creative industries and IP users to engage in more IP trading activities. The IP Training Course aims to equip participants with a comprehensive understanding on the tax implications and planning strategies related to IP and R&D in Hong Kong. Besides the introduction of the patent system in Hong Kong, the course will place particular emphasis on the practical case sharing and illustrative examples regarding the claiming of tax concession under the “patent box” regime.
