**Application for Indemnity Form ("AI") and Gross Fee Income Report
("GFIR") to be submitted online
on or before Saturday, 15 August 2026 5:30 p.m.
(Repeat Circular)**

The professional indemnity cover for all Hong Kong law firms for the 2025/2026 indemnity year will expire on Wednesday, 30 September 2026.

1. Renewal Forms

To renew indemnity, principals of law firms are required to submit an AI and a GFIR (except for new law firms, see paragraph 2(f) below) online via the PIS Digital Platform ("Platform") to the Scheme Manager, ESSAR Insurance Services Ltd. ("ESSAR") under rule 8 of the Solicitors (Professional Indemnity) Rules (Cap. 159M) ("Rules").

A notification email has been sent to the designated principal of each law firm from "do-not-reply@riskonnect.com" regarding the renewal of the 2026/2027 indemnity year via the Platform in Mid-July 2026.

All Hong Kong law firms are required to complete and submit the AI and GFIR (as a scanned (black and white) copy attachment to the AI) executed in accordance with paragraph 2(a)(ii) below to ESSAR via the Platform online **on or before 15 August 2026 at 5:30 p.m.**, for the renewal of their indemnity for the 2026/2027 indemnity year, which commences on 1 October 2026. No physical/ hard copy or other forms will be accepted by ESSAR.

2. The procedure for submitting the AI and GFIR (together the “Documents”) online

a) Execution of the Documents

- (i) The AI must be signed by a principal of the law firm.
- (ii) The GFIR must:
 - (1) be signed by a **Certified Public Accountant (Practising) (“CPA”) reporting the gross fee income of the law firm’s Practice for the immediately preceding accounting year of not less than twelve (12) months;**
 - (2) be issued under the **letterhead of a CPA firm;**
 - (3) specify the **CPA’s full name and Practising Certificate number (at the signature block of the GFIR);**

If this is the law firm’s first time submitting a GFIR, the GFIR should cover the gross fee income of the law firm’s Practice from its commencement date and for not less than twelve (12) months.

If the law firm has changed its accounting year end, the GFIR should cover the period from the law firm’s last reported accounting year end to the immediately preceding new accounting year end.

The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants informed its members through its Circular in May 2022 to utilize the updated GFIR for the purpose of rule 8 of the Rules. The sample wording of the GFIR will be available for downloading when a law firm accesses its AI online.

b) Date of Submission: **on or before 15 August 2026**

- (i) The AI requires a law firm to state the name(s) of the solicitor(s) and foreign lawyer(s) practising under the law firm’s name as at 31 July 2026. This is because under paragraph 2(1)(a) of Schedule 1 to the Rules, with the exception of new law firms, ESSAR will calculate the amount of annual contribution based on the number of solicitors and foreign lawyers on that date.
- (ii) **Under rule 8(1) of the Rules, the last day to submit the Documents is Saturday, 15 August 2026.**

c) Failure to submit the Documents by the statutory deadline of 15 August 2026

Failure to comply with rule 8 is a breach of the Rules. Any failure shall be considered by the Working Party on PIS Gross Fee Income Reports and Contributions (“Working Party”) with recommendations to the Council to take appropriate action.



d) Documents are to be submitted ONLINE ONLY via the Platform

Do NOT send physical or hard copies of the Documents to ESSAR or the Law Society.

e) Application for an Extension of Time: To be sent to The Law Society

If for any reason a law firm is not able to meet the statutory deadline of 15 August 2026, the law firm should make a **PRIOR** application to the Council for an extension of time to submit the Documents, **setting out (i) the period of time extension required and (ii) the reasons for requiring it.** All applications should be addressed to the **Assistant Director, Professional Indemnity Scheme, at The Law Society of Hong Kong, 26/F, The Center, 99 Queen's Road Central, Central, Hong Kong.** Applications should be made **on or before 6 August 2026** as there is **no guarantee** that applications received after this date can be considered by the Working Party before the statutory deadline of 15 August 2026.

f) New Law Firms or Law Firms without the first set of Audited Accounts

A new law firm, i.e. a law firm which commenced practice after 15 August 2025 or a law firm which has not had its first set of accounts audited, will not need to submit a GFIR by 15 August 2026. It must, however, submit an AI online via the Platform by 15 August 2026 to comply with rule 8(1) of the Rules. The new law firm will not need to state the amount of gross fee income in the AI. Pursuant to paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 1 to the Rules, the new law firm will pay a basic average contribution for the PIS renewal for the 2026/2027 indemnity year.

g) Law Firms intending to Cease Practice

Any law firm which intends to cease Practice prior to the commencement of the 2026/2027 indemnity year must comply with Practice Direction D7 of the Law Society Practice Directions. In particular, for the purpose of professional indemnity cover, the law firm **must give notice of cessation to ESSAR at least 8 weeks prior to 30 September 2026.** If the notice period ends on a date after 30 September 2026, the law firm may be required to pay contribution for the whole of the 2026/2027 indemnity year subject to any adjustment to be made upon cessation of Practice.

3. **An email regarding the PIS renewal 2026/2027 has been sent to the designated email address of the designated principal of each law firm on 9 July 2026 by the Law Society. Members are reminded to take note that the email has been sent from "adpis_group@hklawsoc.org.hk".**

26-496 (COM) Practising Certificate (Special Conditions) Rules

Notice of Intention to Apply for a Practising Certificate (2027) (Repeat Circular)

1. The “Notice of Intention to Apply for a Practising Certificate” (the “Notice”) required under Section 5 of the Practising Certificates (Special Conditions) Rules (the “Rules”) is not an application for a practising certificate.
2. The Notice should be completed and declared **only if**:
 - (a) you are applying for the issue of a practising certificate for the first time;
 - (b) you have been censured or ordered to pay a penalty or costs by the Solicitor Disciplinary Tribunal since you were last issued a practising certificate;
 - (c) you have failed or refused to give the Law Society a sufficient and satisfactory explanation in respect of any matter relating to your conduct when invited to do so since you were last issued a practising certificate, and have been notified in writing by the Law Society that you have so failed or refused;
 - (d) you have been suspended from practice since you were last issued a practising certificate and the period of your suspension has expired;
 - (e) you have had your name removed from, or struck off, the Roll of Solicitors since you were last issued a practising certificate and your name has been restored to the Roll of Solicitors;
 - (f) you have become bankrupt since you were last issued a practising certificate and have been discharged;
 - (g) you have had a monetary judgment (not being a judgment excepted under the Rules) given against you since you were last issued a practising certificate;
 - (h) you have not been in full-time practice of law for two continuous years immediately prior to the giving of notice of your intention to apply for a practising certificate (see Circular [04-310 \(SD\)](#) for details); or



- (i) you were a principal in, or consultant of, a firm at the time of an intervention of the firm by the Law Society during the preceding 18 months.
3. Solicitors to whom the Rules apply must give the Law Society at least 6 weeks' notice before applying for a practising certificate. You are encouraged to return the completed Notice to the Law Society **by 18 September 2026**, and in any event, **by 16 October 2026**.
4. Blank copies of the Notice may be obtained from the Law Society or downloaded from the Law Society's website by clicking [here](#). Please click [here](#) for the Notes on How to Fill in the Notice.
5. Late submission of the Notice may delay the processing of your practising certificate application and result in the practising certificate bearing its actual date of issue rather than being backdated. Members are reminded that the Standing Committee on Compliance takes a very serious view of practising without a valid practising certificate.
6. The Notice should be declared before a solicitor of another firm or company in order to comply with Principle 13.09 of The Hong Kong Solicitors' Guide to Professional Conduct Volume 1, 3rd Edition. Please refer to [Principle 13.09](#) for details.
7. The Rules came into effect in February 2003. Please refer to Circulars [03-29\(SD\)](#) and [04-310\(SD\)](#) for details.

26-499 (MS) FREE LEGAL ADVICE SERVICE ON BUILDING MANAGEMENT

Recruitment of Solicitor Volunteers

1. In collaboration with the Home Affairs Department (“HAD”), the Law Society launched the Free Legal Advice Service on Building Management (“the Service”) in January 2015. The Law Society is now looking for more volunteers to participate in the Service.
2. The Service is limited to cases involving building management. HAD’s 18 District Offices receive applications from Owners’ Corporations (OCs), Owners’ committees, Mutual Aid Committees, members of management committees/executive committees of owners/residents organisations, owners, tenants/occupiers. Each applicant is allowed to receive the service once.
3. The eligible cases will be assigned to solicitor volunteers and the completed application form, together with relevant documents, if any, will be sent to the assigned solicitor volunteer at least 5 working days before the scheduled appointment. Interviews will take place at the venues below:

4. On the appointed date, the solicitor volunteer will give verbal advice to the applicant during the interview and put down a brief note of the advice given on an interview record form. There will be no more than 2 interview slots for each solicitor volunteer every night. Each slot will last for about 45 minutes.
5. Solicitor volunteers will be permitted to hand out name cards during the interviews and will receive a modest honorarium, currently HK\$300, to cover traveling expenses to the HAD venues.
6. Members who fulfill any of the following criteria may apply:
 - (a) have completed the “Basic Course on Property Management” (“Basic Course”) **OR**
 - (b) have had over two years of post-qualification experience and have handled not less than ten building management cases in the three years immediately preceding his/her application to join the Panel.
7. Members who have not completed the Basic Course may apply on the condition that he/she will complete the course; and his/her name will be registered with the Service panel automatically upon completion of the course. Please click [here](#) for more information about the upcoming Basic Course.

Basic Course on Property Management

1. The Home Affairs Department, in collaboration with The Law Society of Hong Kong ("Society"), launched the Free Legal Advice Service on Building Management (the "Scheme") on 2 January 2015. To support the Scheme, the Society established a panel of solicitor volunteers ("Panel") to provide pro bono legal advisory services to members of the public.
2. The Hong Kong Academy of Law is providing a training programme on property management for solicitors who would like to be admitted onto the Panel. The training programme consists of five 2-hour sessions. Completion of all 5 sessions of this programme is one of the routes for admission onto the Panel. 1.
